Where authorized by federal or state statute. Ic 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(1), for discussion of strategy with respect to any of the following: collective bargaining. IC 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(6), to discuss before a placement decision an individual student's abilities, past performance, behavior, and needs. ic 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(8), to discuss a job performance evaluation of individual employees. this subdivision does not apply to a discussion of the salary, compensation, or benefits of employees during a budget process. ic 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(9), to train school board members with an outside consultant about the performance of the role of the members as public officials. ic 5-14-1.5- 6.1(b)(11)
