Where authorized by federal or state statute. IC 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(5); With respect to any individual over whom the governing body has jurisdiction to discuss, before a determination, the individual's status as an employee, a student, or an independent contractor who is: (i) a physician; or (ii) a school bus driver. IC 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(6)
