Ic 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(8), to discuss a job performance evaluation of individual employees. This subdivision does not apply to a discussion of the salary, compensation, or benefits of employees during a budget process. Ic 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(9), to train school board members with an outside consultant about the performance of the role of the members as public officials. Ic 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(11)
